Emergency Kits

All students enrolled in Green Valley Christian School are required to have a Disaster Emergency Kit on campus. Each kit should include:

- 1. A labeled **one-gallon Ziplock bag** with your child's name, teacher and room number printed clearly on the side.
- 2. **A 3x5 card** with names and phone numbers of at least three friends or relatives living close to the school who can be contacted in an emergency, along with information regarding any special medical needs or allergies your child may have. It would be helpful to have this card on a piece of yarn so the child may wear it as a necklace for easy identification by teachers and parents.
- 3. One bottle of water
- 4. Non-perishable, tightly sealed food items (granola bars, crackers, etc.).
- 5. Small **flashlight** with batteries or 12-hour life light.
- 6. **Space-age blanket or rescue blanket** (available at Kmart or camping stores comes in a small 3x5" packet) or a large plastic bag.

Please make sure all items you select fit into the one-gallon Ziplock bag.

Please check that foods have a long shelf life and will not spoil. Please do not include loose, perishable or unpackaged food that will attract insects. On the first day of school, bring your child's emergency kit and give it to your child's teacher. The kit will be stored in your child's classroom and returned to you at the end of the school year.
